YARIO (IRE) took command soon after leaving the starting gate, showed the way on an undisputed lead, left the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, then completed the final furlong under a vigorous hand ride. HARD TO EXPLAIN (IRE) unhurried while racing off the rail, had a good late rally down the outside of the course. BLUE RIDER devoid of early foot, came home with a good late rally. VICTORY SIGN finished willingly along the inside. VISION OF

SUNRISE had no rally. YOUNG THE CAN was no factor. MR SAM I AM kept the pacesetter company for three quarters before giving way. STRIKING RIZZI a forward factor while racing four wide until upper lane, flattened out. AUSTIN LAVIVA BABY four wide, was never involved. DANCING CALLING steadied early, failed to threaten. RIZ SAUVAGE offered little. FAIRWAY DRIVE faded after going a half.
