P J'S MAGICAL WINK broke in at the start bumping lightly with INTO THE FRAY who broke out slightly, came under hustling to establish the front, was urged along just off the inside while prompted outside and tracked down along the inside, was fully engaged by the rider at the quarter pole, shook free of his closest pursuers, drew clear under a drive until placed to hand urging inside the final sixteenth to prevail well clear. INTO THE FRAY broke out slightly at the start bumping lightly with P J'S MAGICAL WINK before being taken off, crossed over inside after the start putting BIZARROWORLD in tight between foes, tracked the pace inside scraping the paint until nearing the quarter pole when the eventual winner shifted in slightly while clear, opted to angle out at that station, proved no match through the lane for the aforementioned rival while keeping on well to be safely along for the place. GOODTIME BOY hit the near side stall at the start and was off a beat slow as a result, settled three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, appeared to be attempting to lug in through the stretch as the rider applied a snug grip to the off side rein, keeping the stick work mostly on the near side all the while kicking home mildly for the show honors clear of the rest. BACKDOWN prompted the pace from the three path, came under urging three furlongs from home, got shaken off at the top of the lane by the top pair, kept on until weakening through the final eighth. WHY BROADWAY saved ground towards the rear while chasing under a prolonged drive and passed tired rivals in the stretch. CHRISTOPHER'S JOY midpack chasing while two to three wide, got set down at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. BIZARROWORLD jostled between foes just after the start when INTO THE FRAY crossed over to squeeze him against CHRISTOPHER'S JOY, was taken briefly in hand and extracted from the situation, opted outside to be four wide through the turn, came under urging at the midway point and tired.
