Footnotes

BRIGAND bumped with MOONLIGHT SONG at the break sparred briefly with the same opponent from the outside while making his way down the backstretch, shook free when ready before reaching the half mile pole, sailed along from the two path, facing no real resistance around the turn, began to edge away turning for home, was released from a good hold on the reins by the pilot in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and put to a mild hand ride, scampered away to a comfortable advantage, maintained nearly all of it, while geared down for much of the last sixteenth. BIGGER IS BETTOR underwent a three wide pursuit, proved no match while shying away from the stick work being used by the rider in the late stages. PURE ATTITUDE drifted out during the stretch run but had enough to get up for the show. MINESWEPT chased the winner from the outside and gave way. QUIET FAVORITE got off sluggishly after striking the left side of the starting gate, was towards the inside for a good portion down the backstretch but along the outside on the turn, got placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no rally. FORTITUDE three wide, was asked for a response past the half mile pole, tired. MOONLIGHT SONG made contact with the winner at the start, was quickly taken over to the inside, disputed the pace for nearly a half before beginning a retreat, drifted four wide into upper stretch while tiring.
