Footnotes

BALLERINA BELLE assumed a forward position after leaving the starting gate with no apparent mishap, was in the three path pressing the issue during the opening half, had the middle member of the fight drop back and went at it one with the runner up the rest way around the bend, poked a head in front remaining at a considerable distance from off the hedge, got cued near the three-sixteenths marker before getting asked for a response with an eighth to go, remained well in the clear, hand urged home. BRAIDED along the inside, argued to maintain the advantage while being pursued by another pair parked to the outside, got hooked up a duel with the winner during the later stages of the run around the bend, cut the corner under a full drive only to release the lead nonetheless, fell back steadily from the top one proceeding down the lane, yet remained second best. ZAMQUICK reserved two wide for most of the way on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, got straightened away and closed in willingly to latch on to the well-clustered second flight with a furlong to go, continued onward with good energy to outkick them all and earn the show award. DELANY ROAD off the inside, lacked the needed stretch response. MASASI saved ground and faltered. ROCKABYE LADY three wide entering the turn, was in the fourth path exiting it, made no headway. MISS LAUREN ANN off a beat slowly, was guided over to the hedge in short order, went on to save ground thereafter, launched a rail run commencing from the top of the lane, flattened out in the final furlong. COOL FLAME brushed the right side of the gate after lunging at the start, was pulling on the bit early down the backstretch, disputed the pace from between rivals until about halfway around the turn, tired. SEVERINE along the inside until near the five-sixteenths pole, got taken four wide into the stretch, had no offering. SWEET POTATO two wide at the top of the turn, gave way. CANDY DRAWER lunged upward, making solid contact with the left side of the starting gate and trailed throughout thereafter.
