HARBOR MASTER raced close up early while in hand, rallied outside nearing the stretch and drew clear when roused. DEPUTY INDY raced in hand early, advanced inside on the turn, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. WAR MARSHALL quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. MR. MALAPROP chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. APPRENTICE had no rally. MONOPOLY PRICING tired.
