AWESOME FEATHER came away a bit awkwardly, was grabbed hold and quickly took up a forward position, loosely stalked the pacesetter during the initial stages, moved up willingly when let out a notch approaching the five-sixteenths pole, reached dead even terms with FLYING TRAIN as the pair spun into the lane, was put to stronger handling and fought her way to a clear advantage with a furlong remaining, continued to edge away, crossing the wire under brisk encouragement. SENTIMENTAL LASS took up the chase three wide, was under a drive before reaching the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner while well clear of the others for place honors. FLYING TRAIN hustled away leaving the starting gate, was put under a good hold once a clear lead had been achieved, showed the way being rated in the two path, felt some heat for the initial time late on the turn, had the top one look her in the eye entering the stretch and was asked for a response, failed to keep pace making her way to the eighth pole, then tired steadily. INDIAN LILLY four wide, was urged on the turn but could make no headway on the front runners. WILD BOUT TIFFANY was steadied after being carried inward a few paths at the start, trailed throughout while widest on the turn then was vanned off after the finish.
