PEACE PRESERVER disputed the pace three wide, edged away from a more energetically-handled DOROTHY'S SPIRIT making her way to the quarter pole, was driven out to a sizeable margin during the run through the furlong grounds, heard the muffled hoof beats coming from the fast-closing CERTAINTY and just held on for the verdict. CERTAINTY reserved off the inside during the initial going, picked up the pace late on the turn, was under encouragement settling to be four wide at the head of the stretch, closed with good energy down the center of the course but fell short. VERY SPECIAL LADY gave chase, was let out in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top pair. CENTRIQUE stalked the front runners from near the two path, lacked the necessary stretch response. BLACK TRAIN underwent a three wide journey, had no kick. DOROTHY'S SPIRIT contested the pace placed towards the two path, could not keep up with the winner despite being heavily roused by the five-sixteenths pole and steadily tired. SOUTHERN BIGHT three to four wide, was through after completing six furlongs. COMMANDER SUE sluggish at the start, was outrun. NORMA THE STORMA three to four wide until the quarter pole, failed to reach contention. SAM'S SUNNY CITY a forward factor along the inside, faded. EXPECT THUNDER raced along

the outside and tired.
