Footnotes

BASALT three to four wide in close range under reserve, came under encouragement nearing the quarter pole, took command just prior to that station, edged away under a drive to the sixteenth pole, was under vigorous hand ride to prevail from there clear. GIANT INDIAN saved ground just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, offered up a mild kick through the stretch for the place honors while never threatening the top. GREY FOOSE bumped at the start when BANDITS HEART broke outwards, raced four wide in midpack, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild bid for the show honors in the late stages. BANDITS HEART broke out at the start bumping GREY FOOSE before being taken off, dueled briefly with RAFFIE'S FACTOR before shaking free fighting the bit slightly rank and stargazing into the turn, showed the way from just off the inside, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole, got displaced at that station the rider applying a strong hold on the near side rein seemingly to avoid getting out, kept on through the initial portion of the stretch no match for the winner before weakening inside the final sixteenth. RAFFIE'S FACTOR away well, dueled early on briefly from the inside, got shaken off into the turn, came under coaxing while chasing inside, angled off the rail to the three path straightening for home, weakened in the stretch. QUIET EYES saved ground towards the rear, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole and offered no response. SHANE ROARS chased the front while two to three wide through the turn within striking distance, spun three wide in upper stretch and tired.
