**Footnotes**

FLATTERMEWITHROSES the last one out of the starting gate, launched a mini move while proceeding down the backstretch to attain position in midpack, was strung out in the four path upon entering the turn, got let out a notch about halfway during the run around the bend and began to range up towards the front runners, swung four wide under strong hand urging into the lane, with the runner up loosely drafting behind her, maintained the momentum, closed in and poked a head down in front at the eighth pole, getting there just ahead of another pair, drifted out slightly in deep stretch, crossing over safely in front of COCONUT SHRIMP, remained clear of that opponent to the end, kept under active handling. COCONUT SHRIMP was well off the inside departing the backstretch, got placed four wide at the midway point on the turn, followed the winner from there into the lane, kept at a slight distance behind that foe, and was called upon for a response, made minimal progress from upper to midstretch, altered course to be outside the front threesome approaching end of the furlong grounds, continued onward but was outfinished. DISCREET MARQ assumed a forward position soon after the start, stalked the pacesetter while pulling on the bit down the backstretch, kept pace with HEADING TO TOGA from the three path on the turn, got let and challenged in earnest in the vicinity of the quarter pole, with the top one having made her presence felt by this juncture, failed to keep up with the winner once past the eighth pole, eventually having to settle for the show award. JOHN'S MARIAH along the inside down the backstretch, chose the two path as the route to take around the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. HEADING TO TOGA established control early down the backstretch, settled into being two wide and showed the way from there, with DISCREET MARQ attending one path wider and paying rapt attention, continued along on the same scenario for just over a half, felt a definite increase in pressure nearing the head of the stretch and was set down in answer to it, held on to the lead stubbornly until a stride or so prior to the furlong marker, fell back steadily after relinquishing. SENSATIONAL APPEAL saved ground, the lone member of the group of six to spend the majority of time down near the rail, was already encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, faltered.
