MONEY ONLY took the overland route in the turn settled in midpack, came under a drive just past the three-eighths pole, swung five wide in upper stretch, kicked home down the center of the lane with good energy to just get up on the wire and prevail. POISED TO A TEE three wide just off the pace, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, ranged in to confront the leader at the head of the lane, took over command straightening away, inched away to the furlong grounds, dug in through the final eighth fighting on, got nailed on the wire and forced top settle for the place honors while clear of the rest. PORT CONWAY just off the pace four wide, got set down nearing the quarter pole, loomed at that station, kicked home in striking distance until the final eighth before being out kicked late on by the top pair. VENGEFUL PRIDE three wide towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, swung four to five wide in upper stretch, kicked home belatedly for the last major share. SIDE PARTY RALPH bumped at the start when breaking in a step as SEARCH ENGINE broke outwards a step, raced just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick through the lane. WINNING PAL dueled inside from the get go, came under coaxing when shaking a bit more clear at the five-sixteenths, got confronted by a trio turning for home, yielded the lead at the three-sixteenths and faltered. KERSHNER four wide midpack, shifted inside when having clearance to the inside

just past the three-eighths pole, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, moved briefly into contention at the eighth pole then made no further late headway. SEARCH ENGINE bumped at the start when breaking out and coming together with SIDE PARTY RALPH who came in slightly, saved ground towards the rear, got ridden along from the three-eighths and offered no serious kick. BROOKLYN LEGEND pushed along midpack two to three wide, tired after a half. BIG RED TALENT dueled from the start from just off the inside through solid fractions, came under urging to keep pace at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and folded. SUILLEABHAIN three wide towards the rear, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths, spun five wide in upper stretch and never got involved.
