OUR PATTY raced inside and finished well. SWEET SORROW was bumped at the start, was steadied on the backstretch and raced wide. OLYMPIAN SISTER chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. TELLING TALES (ARG) was bumped at the start, raced between rivals and had no rally.
