APTITUDE was rated along outside, advanced outside leaving the backstretch, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, quickly drew away and widened while being ridden out to the wire. GENEROUS ROSI (GB) was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, could not stay with the winner in the stretch but continued on stubbornly along the rail to hold the second spot. COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, rallied inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. ALBERT THE GREAT was rated outside, advanced outside on the backstretch, put in a wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. SCORPION was hard-ridden while chasing the pace and tired after the opening three quarters. A P VALENTINE was urged along early, raced wide on the second turn and had no response when roused. SUMITAS (GER) chased the pace along the inside, tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
