Footnotes

EXOGENOUS raced close up outside, was put in tight quarters between rivals midway on the turn, rallied wide into the stretch, lugged in and was straightened away in midstretch then lugged in again, brushing with SPAIN in deep stretch and drew clear late under a drive. FLUTE raced close up outside while in hand, altered course to the inside entering the turn, came out midway on the turn, putting the winner in tight quarters then went back to the inside and finished gamely on the rail to get the place prize. SPAIN showed speed from the start, was put to a drive from the outside leaving the backstretch, rallied wide nearing the stretch, battled gamely between rivals and was steadied briefly after being brushed by the winner in deep stretch. CRITICAL EYE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. SERRA LAKE was outrun early, raced inside into the stretch, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and had no rally. BEAUTIFUL PLEASURE was hustled up inside after the start, set the pace, drifted out on the turn and tired after three quarters. PENTATONIC was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. IRVING'S BABY was finished early and was eased in the stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, the result was declared official.
