TEMPTING CHOICE was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. SALTY N' FOXY had no rally. SUNSET EXPRESS contested the pace along the inside and tired. I WILL SURVIVE contested the pace while three wide and tired. CARRIE BOONE raced wide and had no rally. BARGAIN DANCER had no response when roused. INTERLUDE raced wide throughout and tired. LIVEITUPNOW contested the pace while between rivals and tired.
