**Footnotes**

LAUNCESTON quickly established command, shook off an abbreviated bid for the lead from MILITARY STAR, was rated along in the two path on a loose lead until the quarter pole, maintained a clear advantage after being called upon in upper stretch and held sway. BECKON underwent a three wide pursuit, lacked the needed kick to reel in the top one. RAYMOND four wide at the three-eighths pole, bested the rest. LA FESTA E DOMANI drifted six wide into the stretch and managed to improve position during the stretch drive. SILVER BIRCH urged from the gate to assume a forward position, raced three wide around the turn and folded. MILITARY STAR saved ground, made a brief bid for the lead soon after leaving the starting gate before backing off. CRESCENT MOON DR was never in contention. CANDY HEART was through after a half. IMPLIED ODDS urged on the turn, gave way. HARPERS LAND raced off the inside and retreated.
