ENDLESS CIRCLE bided his time during the opening half, while constantly pulling on the right side of the bit, was expertly kept towards the two path for nearly a half mile, found room to be angled three wide turning for home, displayed a good rally once in the clear in upper stretch, forged his way to the front upon reaching the eighth pole, then held sway with the rider flashing the whip from the right side from the sixteenth pole to the finish line. BE BULLISH rated attending the pace from the outside until the three-sixteenths pole, responded positively once called upon, fought gamely for the lead, was no match for the top one during the final sixteenth, but continued on willingly to earn the place. GENERAL MAXIMUS reserved along the outside within range, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind a wall of rivals as the field headed for the top of the lane, altered course to the rail turning for home before commencing to rally, made some progress, altered course a second time, back to the outside this time. was outfinished by the two twosome during the final furlong, but finished with good courage nonetheless en route for the show. EZZY lightly urged to the front, showed the way towards the inside, offered good resistance when put to the test turning for home before weakening during the final furlong. MINESWEPT four wide around the turn, had no rally. DR. W chased three wide and folded.
