SAINTS ALIVE showed the way from the inside, loosely-contested during the run around the bend, was let out leading the field into the stretch and spurred away to a comfortable advantage, held safely under a drive. SLY saved ground and was along for the place. FORALLTHEGLORY rallied mildly to take the

show. TIGER WILLIE unhurried for nearly a half, was already under encouragement spinning seven wide into upper stretch, displayed good, but belated, energy once straightened away to gain ground readily making his way to the wire. JUDGE WELL slipped off the inside past midpoint on the turn, entered the stretch from the six path being roused, flattened out. HOLLYWOOD LEFT a forward factor throughout the opening half, angled three wide coming to the three-sixteenths pole, weakened during the final furlong. FREE BRAVE was bumped at the start and failed to reach a contending position. TAHOE WARRIOR bumped after the start, gave chase for a half before backing away. RAGING SIX off the inside, was no factor. SAM HILLIC was never involved. RETIRE TO WHAT made contact with FREE BRAVE leaving the starting gate, was under a firm hold prompting the pacesetter from the outside, faded after completing a half, was subsequently vanned off, then was reported to have bled. MITIGATION displayed brief foot.
