SHANGHAI BOBBY came away with no apparent mishap and assumed a forward position, rated kindly from the two path while attending the pacesetter, increased his presence near the half mile pole, raced on nearly even terms with the runner up for most of the way around it before edging away a short distance from the quarter pole, led the field into the stretch by a small margin and was soon set down, drifted out more than a lane after being given two left handed shots, was switched over to a brisk hand ride, had already kicked well clear of the others when he drifted outward slightly a second time in deep stretch. GOLDENCENTS ducked inward at the break, narrowly missing striking the side of the starting gate, moved up to grab the advantage, showed the way from the rail, proving to be ratable and under the rapt attention of the eventual winner parked one path to the outside, had the foe drew abreast by the end of the backstretch, fell back slightly as their duel was nearing the quarter pole, continued to lose ground after entering the stretch but held on well to earn the place. FORTIFY forwardly placed while patiently perched three wide off the pacesetter and the primary stalker, proved no match for either of them when set down for the stretch drive. ARCHWARRIOR mildly hand coaxed while chasing the front runners from two path, tired after completing three-quarters. MICROMANAGE three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting it (the widest of all), had no rally. CHIEF HAVOC tucked over to the rail shortly before reaching the end of the backstretch, was eased into the two path at the five-sixteenths marker, spun from the four path into the stretch, failed to fire.
