BERNARDO tracked the runner up from the inside, rallied along the rail to poke a head down in front with an eighth to go, edged away, kept to a strong hand drive. COMANDANTE showed the way from slightly off the inside, began to drift outward after entering the stretch, yielded, held on to the place. PETROCELLI stalked the leader from the outside, held the show. SEA TO SKY three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, had no response. ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY in the three path midway on the turn, tired. ROARING CONQUEST raced three wide on the turn to no avail. ALCOLITE failed to menace off a ground-saving journey. EVERYOTHERDAYHERO was never in the hunt. SKY COLORS offered little and bled. WISE GUIDE drifted into the four path while tiring at the three-eighths pole.
