Footnotes

GLASSY ALY sat forwardly placed at or near the inside until the quarter pole, was drafting behind the pacesetter while proceeding down the backstretch, was given her cue and angled three wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after completing the maneuver, started to drift outward coming to the eighth pole, with an unattached ROCK N COZY following suit, drove past the remaining front runners to take over in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker and kicked clear. LIFE'S A STAGE three wide racing along the elbow chute, was closer to the inside on the full turn, was guided over to the hedge once the top one had abandoned the inside route, cut the corner into the stretch having already been under a drive from near the five-sixteenths pole, finished willingly for the place while unable to gain ground on the winner. TRANSPLENDID contently prompted the pacesetter from the two path for the initial three-quarters, issued a bid for command as the field headed for the stretch, fought her way to a narrow advantage by the end of the furlong grounds, held it for about a sixteenth, weakened steadily thereafter into the show slot. ROCK N COZY sat reserved along the outside until midway on the full turn, got gradually placed into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, continued onward for a little longer and was set down, closed in some during from upper to midstretch, followed the winner outward momentarily then flattened out. CELESTA unhurried in the two path, commenced the stretch six wide, lacked a solid closing response. PEGGY VIRGINIA quickly took control, set the pace, rated while kept at a slight distance from off the hedge, got challenged for the lead as the third fraction was being recorded and was let out, offered some resistance before yielding and faltered. SEE SEE SEE underwent a four wide journey and was no factor. DESTINYS MYSTERY a forward factor while racing three wide, tired. TODAY NOT TOMMOROW rankly pulling on the bit while unsettled wedged in between foes early down the backstretch, found refuge along the hedge, continued to save ground and tired. THE GIANT'S BEAUTY saved ground on both the chute and on the turn and was outrun.
