PICKED OFF, never far back, advanced outside on the turn, dug in resolutely and prevailed after a long, hard drive. PARADICE VICE, outrun early on, raced inside on the turn, altered course to the outside in midstretch and finished with good courage. EXPLETIVE DELETED, hustled along outside, altered course in the stretch and finished well. TRICK E TICKET put in a good run while five wide around the turn, reached even terms nearing the eighth pole but weakened in the final yards. GREEN CHARTREUSE chased the pace from the outside and weakened late. HOLLY GREEN contested the pace and tired in the final furlong. CAROLINA KIDNAP showed good speed along the inside while in hand but lacked a rally. WATERMILL was outrun. DOLABELLA contested the pace and tired after the opening half mile. C QUINTS broke slowly and raced wide. SNORKELING was outrun.
