BARRAGE raced with the pace while three wide and well in hand, took over turning for home and held BROADWAY BARNEY safe under a steady drive. BROADWAY BARNEY, unhurried early, split rivals on the turn and finished gamely on the rail. DE ROMA, outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and had little left for the drive, his rider losing his whip in upper stretch. DIABLO'S CROWN contested the pace for three quarters and tired. MUSASHI put in a run on the turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. NETCOURT, hustled along outside, raced four wide and tired. GULF STORM tired after a five wide trip. HENRY W set the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile. SUGAR MAGS tired badly. MEGAWATT was outrun.
