Footnotes

CAPITESS, rated along inside, came four wide approaching the stretch, dug in determinedly and prevailed despite being carried out through the final sixteenth. CERIDWEN, rated along outside, rallied wide, reached the front in upper stretch and stayed on gamely while drifting out in deep stretch. SOME IRISH LEGEND was off in a tangle, raced wide and finished well. TRICK E TICKET raced inside and lacked a solid finishing kick. LOLLY GO LITELY, outrun early, came wide for the drive but had no rally. IMPULSE SHOPPER contested the pace for three quarters and tired. BOUND TO BE RICH contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. RUN ALEXIS RUN tired after a wide trip. GOLDEN BORDERS raced wide and tired. PETRONIA stopped after showing brief speed.
