DELAWARE TOWNSHIP broke running, raced with the pace while three wide in hand, responded when asked for run entering stretch, quickly drew clear and was ridden out to the wire. HOOK AND LADDER contested the pace along the inside and dug in gamely on the rail through the stretch. YONAGUSKA was outrun early, raced inside and finished well. PEEPING TOM was outrun early, raced outside and had no response when roused. DISCO RICO set the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong.
