Footnotes

BRIGADIER GENERAL broke on top, engaged in a pace dispute with PIKE PLACE while travelling in the two path, successfully fended that challenge by the five-sixteenths pole, with the rider keeping a bit in reserve all the while, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, spurted away to a commanding lead with an eighth to go and held sway under a brisk drive to the wire. FLYING GANG outrun for nearly a half, was put to encouragement, spinning from the two path into the stretch, closed ground readily during the initial portion of the stretch run, altered course to the inside at the sixteenth pole for optimal sailing and displayed good late foot to garner place honors. RADIO ROW saved ground until the quarter pole, was asked for a response after being straightened away, tried to lug in at several points in the lane, forcing the rider to take hold in each instance, continued on willingly nonetheless en route for the show. PIKE PLACE made a three wide challenge for the lead from the nine-sixteenths pole to the five-sixteenths pole before backing off. POWER KING took the overland route around the turn, made a middle move under encouragement but could not sustain the bid after entering the stretch. WING GLIDER raced three wide and tired after going a half. WESLEY MAJOR off the inside, failed to reach a contending position. WILDCAT STEVIE underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn and folded.
