Footnotes

SYROS sat well reserved from off the inside for nearly three-quarters pole, was asked to pick up the pace angling outward at the five-sixteenths pole, issued a challenge for the lead, the widest of three front runners spinning into the lane, grabbed control making his way to the eighth pole, dug in with good determination to preserve it. DODGING three wide on the opening bend, was placed closer to the inside upon reaching the backstretch, rated well while prompting the pacesetter from the outside, continued along on the same scenario until late on the turn, got asked for some run challenging GO TO THE NET from between rivals as the field headed towards the top of lane, fought well throughout the stretch drive, wasn't able to match strides with the winner but finished willingly to procure the place. JABULANI broke near the top but was allowed to ease back into midpack, rated kindly from off the inside, had the rider release a snug hold on the reins about midway on the far turn, angled outward for the stretch run and was set down, rallied with good energy en route for the show. DR. KENNEY broke inward a bit leaving the starting gate, settled near midpack along the outside, remained unhurried within range until the quarter pole, turned for home and was asked for run, displayed a mild kick travelling down the course to secure the last major check. GRIFFIN ROCK placed four wide at the top of the lane, went on to improve position. DYNAMITE DUDE was carried in slightly at the start, was put to some urging to secure a forward position and after having achieved the goal before leaving the homestretch, was put to a good hold, tracked the front runners from the near the hedge, waited briefly behind rivals approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was called upon, altered course outward a path in midstretch, finished fairly evenly thereafter. GO TO THE NET broke running and quickly established control, was rated along the inside cutting the pace, came under assault nearing the quarter pole and soon succumbed. WIN THE DAY saved ground to no avail. PLEASANTRENDEZVOUS loped along during the initial

stages, was guided into the three path departing the backstretch, failed to reach contention. TRULY SMART strung out four wide on the first turn, was well off the inside until the five-sixteenths pole, cut the corner into the lane tiring.
