Footnotes

SUS ANNMARIES GOLD came out of the starting gate without incident and took up a forward position, sat parked three wide on the turn under some coaxing to keep pace with fighting front runners a short distance up ahead, got called upon in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and began to close in, reached the eighth pole only heads apart with the runner up, took over after going another two jumps and kicked away, kept to a hand drive. RIPHTHERUBBEROFF came out a bit at the break resulting in making light contact with WINMOR GOLD, got hooked in a duel with ACCOMPLISH FIRST nearly from the get-go, raced as a team with that rival during the run around the turn, was the first of the pair to have the pilot commit to some kind of encouragement, doing so a couple of jumps before arriving at the quarter pole, shook off her chief nemesis only to have the top one become her replacement, surrendered to the fresher challenger a short distance past the eighth pole but continued onward with good courage to secure second. ACCOMPLISH FIRST sparred intensely with the runner up from the two path until upper stretch before giving way. T C LANE sat in the pocket well within range of an ongoing pace dispute, was put to a drive angling outward for the stretch drive, came up empty. THERAPY gave chase from the two path on the turn, was given some taps near the right shoulder midpoint on the turn but left it still unmotivated, got set down entering the stretch, raced greenly down the lane, drifted outward at several intervals after being on the receiving end of some left handed stick work, while drifting in the direction of the rail whenever the whip was not being used, failed to have an impact. WINMOR GOLD brushed at the start, went on to save ground to no avail.
