SUMMER REVIVAL broke on top, albeit by a narrow margin and went on to secure the early advantage, argued to maintain it while saving ground, felt the presence of the runner up late on the turn and got called upon in response, turned for home from the two path, edged away from CONCORDE'S PEACE during the ensuing furlong while keeping a fairly straight course, drifted out once past the eighth pole yet held on safely. CONCORDE'S PEACE ranged up three wide on the turn under his own power, reaching a good striking position by the quarter pole, turned for home and got called upon, failed to make any additional progress on the winner and had to settle for being well clear of the others for place honors. I WISHED underwent a four wide pursuit and had no rally. IRON CAFE four wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. GOT A HUNCH raced along the outside, was asked for run by the midway point on the turn, never threatened while improving position by weak and tired ones in the stretch. MONEY IN RETURN three wide departing the backstretch, was through after completing a half. THAT'S GIN pressed the issue from the two path, backed away before going a half despite having been heavily roused. MONSIGNOR J raced from off the inside, was hustled along from the very early stages, raced around the turn from the two path under a prolonged drive, tired. MULLIGAN MAN lunged at the break, darted over to the rail, faded off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
