Footnotes

LA CAT never far back, stalked the pace while three wide along the backstretch, launched a rally from outside on the turn, closed the gap to challenge in midstretch then drew clear in the final eighth. TWILIGHTS PRAYER sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace along the rail into midstretch and held well for the place. YOUNG MAN'S FANCY was reserved off the pace while saving ground to the turn, angled between horses on the turn, swung out in upper stretch and rallied mildly. PRIME QUEEN raced just inside the winner for five furlongs, lodged a bid three wide on the turn but couldn't sustain her rally. DROMARA was in tight at the start, raced in traffic between horses on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. SILVER TIARA failed to threaten while saving ground. GETADDERIT never reached contention after being pinched back at the start. THE NUMBERS ADD UP raced up close along the rail to the turn then gave way. ABOUT RESPECT lodged a bid four wide to reach contention on the turn then flattened out.
