ZAPSTER sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace along the rail into midstretch, dug in leaving the eighth pole and prevailed under steady urging. REMITTANCE settled in the three path for a half, swung five wide on the turn then closed steadily but couldn't catch her entymate. MONTESQUIEU pressed the winner between horses for most of the way and weakened late. PRECIPICE TRAIL steadied in traffic on the far turn, split rivals while four wide nearing the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. TICONDERO raced in midpack between horses, angled in on the turn and finished evenly. MY TAPIT failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. RYVIT steadied in traffic earl, saved ground for six furlongs, swung wide on the turn and lacked a late response. TIGER WILLIE raced in good position along the rail and gave way on the turn. MYSTIC FEVER raced just off the early pace from outside, circled four wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. HERO'S EMPIRE saved ground to no avail.
