Footnotes

THOSE WER THE DAYS well out in the track, patiently stalked the pacesetter from long distance, closed in on that opponent departing the half mile pole, while still well in hand, altered course inward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole before commencing to rally, overhauled a weakening ONE TURN EDDIE to take charge before reaching the eighth pole then drew clear while being kept to the task at hand. WILDLEE SPECIAL lunged at the break, was content to race unhurried towards the back of the pack down the backstretch, began a long forward march upon reaching the turn, was guided over into the three path at the three-eighths pole, then rallied willingly after entering the stretch to take second. ONE TURN EDDIE sped off to a sizeable lead on his own power soon after the start, continued to set the fractions well rated and in the two path, began to shorten stride approaching the quarter pole, drifted out a

couple of paths spinning into the lane, readily yielded by midstretch and steadily tired thereafter. GAMBLIN FEVER outrun for nearly six furlongs, angled three wide into the stretch and went on to best the rest. SCORCH THE TORCH lacked a rally. PAGAN RULER loosely tracked the leader from the rail and tired. SOUND CHASER was through after completing three-quarters. GREEN BANANAS put to a prolonged drive, failed to reach a contending position. NOBODY LIKE MIKE swung four wide into the lane and had no kick. MOON RAVEN faded after a half.
