Footnotes

EAST INDIES quickly grabbed the front, cut the pace from the inside, with FORE PALS tagging along directly behind from the two path and applying honest pressure, continued along on the same scenario down the backstretch and around the far turn as well, was called upon leading the field into the stretch, opened up a comfortable advantage by the eighth pole and held sway, driving. OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) raced along the outside, was put to prolonged encouragement, starting from near the three-eighths pole, scurried past rivals to be closest to the winner leaving the eighth pole, then had just enough left at the end to salvage second. RUBBER DUCK (GER) got pin-balled at the break, bouncing around and getting bumped between rivals, sat reserved near the back for the pack during the initial stages, picked up interest late on the far turn, cut the corner into lane under some rousing, and finished with good belated energy, missing out on place honors. PERFECT JOISKI took up the chase from off the inside, was urged spinning into the lane from the three path, got out

finished. FORE PALS broke outward bumping with nearest rival, assumed a forward position soon afterwards, was coaxed along attending the pacesetter from the outside, fell back steadily after entering the stretch. TWOJOHNSANDAJACK saved ground and was no factor. TOMMY KARAKORUM tracked the leader while taking the inside route, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, but failed to make any headway. AVENGING had a three wide journey and gave way. PATENT PENDING TOM bumped at the start, was strung out three wide making his way to the backstretch, failed to reach a contending position. GRAMERCY saved ground on the far turn and tired. TOCCT'S IMAGE four wide entering the backstretch, offered little.
