PRECIOUS METAL unhurried proceeding down the backstretch, picked up the pace noticeably upon reaching the turn, sped his way into contention during the run around the bend, angled outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, wrested away the three path from STROLLDOWNBROADWAY and spun into the stretch, sustained the momentum, gaining the advantage before reaching the eighth pole, edged away under good handling. CARSON BANDIT argued for command from the inside, got let out entering the stretch, was unable to match strides with the eventual winner but continued onward willingly to procure the place. WINDAFULL took the inside route, was taken off the hedge for the stretch drive, was pushed along attempting to split rivals in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, hesitated just long enough to fail in the task, displayed good late energy a furlong down the road to grab the show. STROLLDOWNBROADWAY appeared unsettled stalking the front runners, under a firm hold, from off the inside, with the rider steadying the mount nearing the half mile pole as a result, continued the pursuit, but now placed three wide, lost position when beaten to the three path by the top one approaching the head of the stretch, was called upon and got outfinished. ROARING SEASONS vied for command from the two path, remained a prominent factor before giving way in midstretch. SAM'S BUCK saved ground on the turn and went on to improve position. FORTY TEARS raced three wide and was no threat. POLARIS DREAM was three wide and under encouragement by the three-eighths pole, came up empty. MIDNIGHT MAX cut the corner into the lane, had no rally. T C H WARRIOR departed the backstretch three wide and was through after completing a half. RAFFIE'S CHOICE raced along the outside and always trailed.
