Footnotes

MONZANTE raced three wide until the quarter pole, accelerated towards the front runners when asked for some run midway on the turn spun four wide into the stretch and rallied in earnest, closed in well during the ensuing furlong, struck the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, edged away and dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. INDY SCENT sat reserved for nearly three-quarters, was driven five wide into the stretch and charged home

with good energy to take the place. DJOKOVIC saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, finished willingly en route for the show. MUTINY contently tracked the front runners sitting a loose pocket, was eased outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home three wide, ducked back over to the rail a few strides into the stretch drive, bid boldly from the inside before flattening out leaving the furlong grounds. KID CURRY placed four wide at the top of the lane, rallied well. PICO DINERO chased from afar for a good portion down the backstretch, began to close the gap nearing the half mile pole, was coaxed along keeping just off the leader's hind quarters making his way around the bend, cranked up the pressure approaching the quarter pole and soon took over, relinquished with a sixteenth remaining and steadily weakened. HANSON HEIGHTS saved ground until the quarter pole. JET TO CLASSICS made a three wide down the chute to grab the front, showed the way on an open lead for most of the initial half, felt the presence of the closest pursuer upon reaching the turn, got put to test approaching the quarter pole and succumbed. R J HOPE off the inside, was outrun. MINT MAKER had a three wide journey, was under encouragement by the three-eighths pole, folded. FAIRWAY DRIVE sat between foes in midpack, was eased coming to the furlong marker before being pulled up, then got vanned off.
