Footnotes

UNION BOSS assumed a forward position soon after the start, closed a significant early gap from the three path during the run around the bend, took over from a tiring rival by the quarter pole, arrived at the eighth pole with none latched on, continued to edge away, crossing the finish line being gingerly hand urged. AFRICAN JAZZ three wide departing the backstretch, rallied for the place. PRINCESS REYANA underwent a two path pursuit, was taken hold forced to pause off the tiring former pacesetter in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got going soon afterwards and angled a bit wider into the stretch, remained a prominent factor for an additional furlong then flattened out. MISS LIBBY raced along the outside, made steady progress from upper to midstretch, altered

course to the outside at the eighth pole and was up in time for the last major check. STILL WAITING tracked the leader while taking the inside route, had no rally. DESTINATION MOON placed six wide at the head of the stretch, mustered up a mild response to improve position. GLYNISTHEMENACE got off slowly after leaping up at the break, raced outside and failed to contend. TATOO ME stumbled at the start, had a ground-saving journey, tired after leaving the furlong grounds. RIPLEY'S GOLD sped off from the competition, showed the way being primarily two wide, was shortening stride by the five-sixteenths marker, faded. LEADING CITIZEN three wide on the turn, was outrun. GET ER UP was unable to avoid the ill-fated foe, bumping soundly with that rival in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, was taken over to the extreme outside and eased. JOY RISING broke down before the end of the backstretch, and was humanely put down.
