Footnotes

GREED AND FEAR came away from the starting gate without apparent incident, picked up interest departing the backstretch, chased the ongoing pace dispute from the four path around the turn, was under a drive spinning just a bit wider into the stretch, took control before reaching the end of the furlong grounds, drifted out slightly in deep stretch but with the outcome no longer in doubt. JAYEZAA sat entrenched in the two path for just over a half, argued to maintain a slim advantage, with another twosome parked in the two paths directly to the outside, emerged the victor of this skirmish by upper stretch but wasn't able to fend off the winner's challenge and relinquished, held on willingly enough to fend off CLEVER COOKIE's late comeback bid. CLEVER COOKIE disputed the pace as the widest of three from the four path from the five-eighths pole until late on the turn, held on reasonably well against weak and/or green rivals to secure the show. STUNNING LADY broke awkwardly, making solid contact with MISS TAPIT as a result, appeared rank proceeding much of the way down the backstretch fighting with visible force on the bit, raced three wide around the turn, swung five into upper stretch, made no headway on the front runners. CONZIG contested the pace racing between rivals from the five-eighths pole until the five-sixteenths marker and gave way. MISS TAPIT got bumped coming out of the starting gate, showed greenness making her way towards the half mile pole by fighting vigorously on the bit and coming out several paths, settled down and strode much more professionally during the run around the bend, commenced the stretch drive, about three wide and being ridden out, was taken slightly more outward to remain safely distanced from MILESTONE MISS near midstretch after that rival moved out a couple of paths suddenly, continued down the lane the same way she began it, ridden out. MILESTONE MISS saved ground and faded.
