### Footnotes

GREENWOOD LAKE, allowed to settle into stride after the start, was hustled along to keep up on the backstretch, picked it up while four wide on the turn, advanced steadily from the outside into the stretch, caught CHIEF SEATTLE inside the sixteenth pole and was clear under the line, a driving winner. CHIEF SEATTLE came away in good order and was sent up to take the lead soon after the start, set the pace along the inside, turned back HIGH YIELD in upper stretch, drew clear past the eighth pole and stayed on gamely but could not resist the winner. HIGH YIELD, taken in hand while with the pace from the outside, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch, could not get to CHIEF SEATTLE and faded in the final furlong. BULLING, outrun early, raced three wide on the turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked a rally. MORE THAN READY, in hand after the start, moved up between rivals to argue the pace but was finished after the opening three quarters. TRADITIONALLY, close up outside while in hand, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SETTLEMENT raced close up early while under stout restraint, angled to the inside on the backstretch and gave futile chase before tiring in the stretch.
