KITTEN'S JOY raced close up inside while in hand, came wide into the stretch, responded when roused and drew away, driving. THE PENNY DROPS raced close up outside, rallied three wide on the second turn, could not stay with the winner in the stretch and continued on to hold the place spot. KENNEL UP was rated along early, raced inside and finished well on the rail. RESTIGOUCHE was outrun early, rallied three wide on the second turn and was steadied in the stretch. AUTO PILOT raced in hand outside, put in a four wide run on the second turn and faded in the stretch. GENEROUS ONE raced close up early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the drive. BRAVE COLUMBUS raced with the pace along the inside, saved ground and had no response when roused. THERMOSTAT had no rally. ADMIRALTY INLET raced wide throughout and tired. IMPERIAL RULER set the pace along the inside and tired.
