DYNERGY raced with the pace while three wide, responded when roused and drew away under a drive. SEMPER FI raced close up early, came wide into the stretch and rallied to get the place spot. BRAVE SIR ROBIN was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. URBAN CONQUEST was outrun early, raced wide and had no rally. NOHASSLATDCASTLE raced wide throughout and had no response when roused. MALIBU SUNSET contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. QUESTIONING contested the pace along the inside and tired. SLOW SIGNAL raced close up outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. DR. QUIRK was outrun along the inside.
