BROAD RIVER opened a wide gap in the early stages, set the pace in hand, dug in when threatened on the turn, maintained a clear lead into midstretch and edged away under left hand urging. EXPANSION settled in the middle of the pack from outside, closed the gap between horses to reach contention on the turn, swung four wide entering the stretch and closed late to gain the place. GIMME CREDIT raced up close in the two path, gained along the inside leaving the turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. BLUES STREET chased the winner in the two path, lodged a bid outside the winner to challenge on the turn and weakened in the final eighth. NERGAL (FR) raced well back for a half, swung five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. GIANT CHIEFTAN failed to mount a serious rally. SLAMBINO never reached contention.
