Footnotes

A WORD TO THE WISE sprinted clear, led on the rail the entire way and drew off under good handling. TIMELY COMMAND raced in good position along the rail into upper stretch and held well for the place. A. P. LIGHT raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground, rallied in traffic along the fence in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. LORRAINE IN SPAIN was reserved for six furlongs, advanced four wide on the turn and rallied mildly. HIER ENCORE raced inside for a good part of the way and lacked a strong closing response. LADY'S WISH checked in traffic early and failed to threaten thereafter. FLYING SAPPHO failed to mount a serious rally along the inside and raced in traffic along the rail through the stretch. ELENI'S HOPE steadied early and was never close thereafter. BAREFOOT BABE pressed the winner to the turn and gave way. MYNIA steadied in traffic while well back in upper stretch. WISE CHOICE stalked three wide to the turn and tired.
