Footnotes

SALUTING STORMYE patiently stalked the front runners from the three path, made a successful three wide bid for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when given his cue in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds still comfortably in front and held sway, driving. STORM ISLAND three wide around the turn, was asked to pick up the pace approaching the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top one after turning for home, but held well to secure the place. AHOY THE STORM raced off the inside, was set down at the three-eighths pole and rallied for the show. SEREN TRIPPIDY unhurried towards the two path for nearly five furlongs, commenced to rally after entering the stretch, split rivals at the eighth pole and continued onward willingly enough for the last major share. SEEKING ANITA saved ground until the quarter pole, ventured off the rail only long enough to clear a fading foe, before being taken back to the inside. PALACE PRANKSTER ranged up in hand from the two path on the turn, but could not sustain the move.

VAMEL along the outside, steadied off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, came home with a mild rally to improve position. DIXIELORE vied for the lead along the inside for a half and faltered. BAIL OUT THE BANKS three wide, was urged on the turn, but could make no headway on the front runners. D'SLEWSTER saved ground to no avail. STROLLDOWNBROADWAY contested the lead from the two path and gave way. TERROX trailed.
