LEAVE OF ABSENCE unhurried early on, settled towards the rear, maneuvered three to four wide around the turn, commenced a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide at the head of the lane, rallied steadily through the furlong grounds to get up in the final yards. KATZ MY SONG tracked the leader from the three path throughout, was roused coming to the quarter pole and responded readily rallying to lead at the eighth pole, fought on well through the final eighth succumbing in the final strides. MYSTICISM broke sharply under light urging to the front, set the pace while saving ground throughout, was called upon nearing the quarter pole, succumbed at the eighth pole, battled on well holding on for the show honors. FUSA CODE saved ground throughout, cut the corner into the lane while under a drive that commenced midway on the turn, steadied briefly just past the three-sixteenths pole when SIX FLINGS came in under right handed pressure, stayed on track continuing a mild rally thereafter for the last major share. ORSONIAN tracked in behind rivals down the backside, swung three wide around the turn, was set down at the five-sixteenths and commenced a mild bid, flattened out in the final sixteenth. SIX FLINGS chased the front from the two path around the turn, got asked midway on the turn for run, came in forcing FUSA CODE to steady briefly just past the three-sixteenths when under right handed pressure, tired in the final sixteenth.
