RULE BY NIGHT was rated prompted the pacesetter from the two path until the three-sixteenths pole, reached that station on nearly even terms with the leader and was let out, as was SUNRISE SMARTY, left the eighth pole clinging to a narrow advantage, then dug in with good determination to preserve it, crossing the wire being hand urged. SUNRISE SMARTY showed the way from the inside, well rated until upper stretch, was asked for run in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, relinquished when unable to match speed with the winner, but continued on willingly to procure the place. FLAT BOLD was rated under stout restraint under the quarter pole, secured the four wide path at the five-sixteenths pole gearing up for the stretch drive, bid in earnest entering the lane, loomed briefly just behind the front runners with a furlong remaining, but soon flattened out. THIS ONES FOR PHIL broke outward and went on to bump with PASHITO CHE, sat reserved between rivals for a good portion of the run around the turn, lacked the needed response when called upon. SUPER ROBUSTO brushed with PASHITO CHE shortly after the start, left the backstretch three wide, was under a drive by midpoint on the turn, failed to gain any ground. RILEY TUCKER tired off a ground-saving journey. BANK MERGER raced three to four wide on the turn, was asked for a response at the three-eighths pole, failed to pick up interest. PASHITO THE CHE bobbed, then got bounced around between the nearest opponents on each side, falling back during the initial stages of the event as a result, was well off the inside and outrun thereafter.
