KANAGARO forwardly placed leaving the starting gate, ranged up to contest the pace departing the backstretch, was the outermost of a foursome that battled their way to the quarter pole, was asked for some run as the skirmish continued for another sixteenth, edged away to a clear advantage with a furlong remaining, then dug in under a drive to preserve the decision. DREAM MAN stumbled after appearing to strike GOLD TRADER from behind soon after the start, sat reserved and bided time from the two path until the quarter pole, made a sharp right angle turn into the four path heading into the stretch, and was immediately roused after finishing off the maneuver, came home with good energy down the center of the course to garner the place. VOLCANO RUN moved up along the inside to dispute the pace, was the innermost of four fighting for control for most of the run around the bend, held gamely to the end to earn the show. GOLD TRADER looked to get clipped behind by the runner up approaching the end of the chute, settled into midpack and remained unhurried from off the inside for nearly three-quarters pole, picked up the pace nearing the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane and displayed good courage to grab the final major award. DYNAMAKER three wide on the far turn, rallied mildly. UNPRECEDENTED broke open the gate while being loaded in, proceeded to come out with no apparent mishap, was under encouragement contesting the pace from between rivals for a quarter of a mile, commencing from the seven-sixteenths pole, weakened departing the furlong grounds. MAGNIFICENT MOON three wide, fought for command between opponents from the seven-sixteenths pole until upper stretch before backing away. CATLETTSBURG broke slowly, was placed five wide for the stretch drive, lacked a kick. LAST HURRAH urged on the second turn, folded. ROARS MORE was never involved. THISSKYSABEAUTY took the overland route throughout and tired. R
