THIRD KNIGHT isolated between flights two to three wide down the backside and into the far turn, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, took closer order on the front, swung four wide for home, rallied into contention a furlong out, took over a sixteenth from home and inched away in the late stages kept to task. BEELINER pressed the pace two to three wide, took over narrowly midway on the turn and shook away through the latter portion to the quarter pole, got roused at that station, dug in confronted a furlong from the wire, fought on inside but was displaced a sixteenth out, continued on to safely garner the place second best. SUMMER SANDS two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, offered up a belated kick to secure the show. SATURDAY APPEAL hustled from the start, was lightly coaxed on the pace just off the inside under pressure throughout, got headed midway on the turn and was asked at the five-sixteenths, angled two to three wide for home, kept on mildly then weakened in the late stages. CANDY RAIDER saved ground towards the rear, commenced a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and offered no response. EL OH EL chased three to four wide into the far turn, shifted to the inside commencing encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and tired. JAMES JINGLE off half a beat slow then shied in a bit at the start as BEAT OF THE DRUM broke inwards, chased three wide from afar towards the rear, came under the whip at the half mile pole and never factored. BEAT OF THE DRUM broke in at the start, raced four wide in close pursuit of the front, came under urging three furlongs out, retreated in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
