MAH JONG MADDNES unhurried while racing from off the inside, tipped into the three path nearing the five-sixteenths marker, swung one path into the lane under encouragement, maintained the momentum and outkicked all front runners during the ensuing furlong to arrive at the eighth pole with none latched on, extended the winning margin, kept to a hand drive. DOUBLE THE ENERGY rated while prompting the pacesetter from the two path, held on well to secure second after getting asked for run. DESERT BLISS rode the hedge until coming to the quarter pole, unasked for speed, got put to a drive angling into the five path during the initial portion of the stretch drive, had a good finish down the outside of the course en route for the show. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE was on the track well before the rest of the post parade, left the gate without apparent mishap and was guided over to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, altered course sharply with about a sixteenth to go, bumping with ROSES FOR ROMNEY as a result, continued to rally mildly after completing the maneuver to grab the last major check. AVE'S HALO chased the front runners three wide, was in a bit tight for one jump near the head of the stretch as the winner spun into it, lacked the needed response. RAKIN' GOLD took control, was rated along the inside, pulling with force on the left side of the bit, came under heavy pressure approaching the top of the lane and was let out in response, yielded travelling through the furlong grounds and gave way.

ROSES FOR ROMNEY raced between rivals for much of the way to the quarter pole, got bumped and then steadied while DOWNTOWN HOTTIE was working her way to the outside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, failed to regain any interest. JITNEY kept watch in the pocket and came up empty. ORNELIA three wide departing the backstretch, was asked for run by the five-sixteenths pole, tired.
