WAGON LIMIT, away in good order and reserved early, was asked to pick it up on the second turn, rallied along the inside into the stretch, kept coming under strong handling and drew away late. GENTLEMEN (ARG) was sent up along the inside from the start, dueled with SKIP AWAY to the top of the stretch, drew clear in upper stretch but began to labor along the rail leaving the eighth pole and could not handle the winner's late run. SKIP AWAY broke alertly and went up to contest the pace from the outside, dueled with GENTLEMEN for the lead then could not stay with that rival turning for home and faded in the drive. RUNNING STAG, rated along inside, put in a run along the rail on the second turn but could not gain ground in the stretch. FIRE KING raced inside and tired. PACIFICBOUNTY chased outside and tired.
