THE GROOM IS RED, unhurried while outrun early, split rivals while rallying on the turn, came wide entering the stretch, stormed down the center of the track and was going away under the wire. LEMON DROP KID, close up inside early, came off the rail to launch a rally midway around the turn, earned a brief lead in deep stretch but could not handle the winner's late charge. WEEKEND MONEY was sent out to the lead after the start, set the pace away from the inner railing and stayed gamely on down to the wire. PRIME DIRECTIVE, unhurried early while his stablemate cut out the pace, rallied five wide on the turn and finished with good courage. TACTICAL CAT was hustled to be with the pace early, chased WEEKEND MONEY along the inside for three quarters and gave way. ALY'S ALLEY was bumped at the start, raced inside and had no response. MEDIEVIL HERO was bumped at the start, chased the pace from the outside and tired.
