WHITEWASHED was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely when roused and prevailed under a drive. SOUNDS FISHY set the pace along the inside and dug in gamely on the rail in the stretch. HANNIE'S CANDY pressed the pace from the outside and was outfinished while between rivals in the stretch. MULTITUDINOUS chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. POLKA QUEEN was outrun early, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally outside. CECILIA'S GIRL was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. WHATA SMOOTHIE raced inside and had no response when roused. CUT A WAGER raced between rivals and tired.
